- On **ONE.UF** (https://one.uf.edu), students can view "**Action Items**," then choose "**To-Dos**" to complete any and all requirements to receive the aid you have been offered. "To-Do" items include verification documentation that must be completed before some aid can be disbursed.
 - If your application is selected for verification, you will receive official notification from the Department of Education via your Federal Student Aid Report (SAR). **Do not submit any documents unless we request that you do so.**
 - Aid funds cannot be disbursed to you until you have submitted all requested documents and the accuracy of the information has been reviewed.
